Thank you for purchasing Lithuania map for Garmin devices.

We hope it will help you while traveling in Lithuania. We will appreciate if you will find a time to report all found errors and bugs - please send them to info@garmin-maps.lt. By doing this you will help yourself, and other users of this map too, as we intend to release new updates with these corrections. All registered users will have possibility to download these updates by Internet, FREE of charge. You will be informed about the new update available to your registered Email address. Enjoy your trips in Lithuania!

1 - Connect to Internet and go to site http://my.garmin-maps.lt/en/disp.php/en_index/en_codes.

2 - If you have not done already, download and install on your computer the Garmin Communicator Plugin plugin, see link at the top of the page. Once installed, it will restart the web browser. The plugin only works with IE and Safari latest browsers. We recommend using the IE browser. After restarting the browser, this item is no longer needed to carry out.



3 - In the new window enter your digit coupon code. Click „Register coupon code“. If you are already registered with Garmin zoned site, enter your email address on the right. E-mail address and password and click "Login." If you have forgotten your password, the system can remind him. Pressing the "Login" proceed from the 5 step.

If you have not registered, garmin-maps.lt website, click on "Begin the registration"

4 - Enter your personal data into the corresponding fields. **Important** - Enter your **REAL and working E-mail address** - it will be used for the future connections, also for the lost password delivery. When all entered - click „Register“

5 - Next step is VERY IMPORTANT. You must enter your internal ID of GPS navigator. **Make sure you enter a correct data, as it will be not possible to execute this registration under**

the same coupon code once again!

The main parameter of this procedure - a unique internal code of your GPS device (Unit ID). This code can be found in the following way, connect your GPS device (preferably disconnect other USB storage equipment such as scanners, memory cards, USB keys or other GPS devices) to your computer's USB port and the Windows operating system will recognize it (the message on the introduction of a new installation) press box "Detect GPS Unit" button. If not, check the Garmin Communicator Plugin installed plug-in described in the second Above. If you are not sure whether the Unit ID is correct, open a new browser

window <http://update.garmin-maps.lt/index.php?swlang=en> link to the detected device will appear in square brackets Unit ID.

6 – If all goes well, the page field "GPS Unit ID" will be filled in automatically. It is also available in the field of automated model-complete if it is not changed, the model must be selected from the list. The serial number is not detected automatically, you need to enter them manually.

7- All went again to check and click on the "Generate unlock code".

8- When the next window, you notice that the map code generated successfully, press the link „**Take me to map updating area**“. Link - <http://update.garmin-maps.lt/index.php?swlang=en>

9- In the next browser window registered product map will be updated to your GPS receiver. Select the desired map product (s) (if you have a few registered products) and click "**Continue**." If in the device was previously installed other maps using MapSource or Basecamp software, you will see an alert box that previously installed map will be removed (this does not affect the factory Garmin's product, such as City Navigator maps, they are left undisturbed during the upgrade). Click "Ok" and the installation procedure will start. At the end of the map loading procedure, you will receive a confirmation message in a new window.

Note: The procedure described in step 9 (uplading map to the GPS device) can be repeated, product registration, as described above, is not required.

10 - If all goes well, you should get a message window shown below. In this case, you are ready to disconnect the GPS receiver from the computer.

Useful tip: To use the map on your computer, download and install the free Garmin Basecamp software. Then connect the GPS device with pre-installed maps to your computer and run the Basecamp software. When Basecamp detects your GPS device and retrieve installed maps, you can work with them directly on the computer. Maps will only work if they are in the connected GPS receiver.

Important information about older Garmin models

(eTrex Legend HCx, Vista HCX, GPSMAP-60Cx/CSx, GPSMAP-76Cx/CSx, ASTRO-220)

In order to succeed map uploading procedure before starting to upload them to these GPS devices it is necessary to carry out the steps described below:

1. If you have the information needed MicroSD memory card, make sure to back it up. This can be done in several ways. First - remove the memory card and insert it into the memory card reader. Second - switching the GPS device to the USB storage mode. This can be done through the device MENU by going to the Main Menu -> Settings -> Interface -> USB storage device ("Main Menu -> Setup -> Interface -> USB Mass Storage). Once this is done you will see a new computer media (removable drive), and a content of MicroSD memory card.
2. Saving necessary data on a PC, delete everything on the card. It has to be empty.
3. Reboot the device (turn-off).

When you do this, you can begin to map the charging procedure described above. If the map uploading fails, try to reformat the card to FAT32 file systems.

Note: If you want to use a map with a Basecamp software, these devices need to be switched to USB storage mode, or you can remove from the device and insert the memory card into a memory card reader that connects to a computer's USB port.
